SELECT DISPLAY DEVICE = CRT+LCD PANEL TYPE = 0A Press ESC to exit menu

In **POWER MANAGEMENT SETUP** set the following: SOFT-OFF BY PWRBTN = DELAY 4 SEC. Press ESC to exit menu

In **PnP/PCI CONFIGURATIONS** set the following: PNP OS INSTALLED=YES RESET CONFIGURATION DATA=ENABLED Press ESC to exit menu

4. Closing the editor:

Move the cursor to: **SAVE AND EXIT SETUP** and press enter Press Y and enter to save the new settings.
